

Listening to the Shepherd's Voice



A shepherd brings his flock of sheep into a pen for the night. A few minutes later, another shepherd brings his flock into the pen. Then yet another shepherd brings his sheep into the pen. There are three groups of sheep in the pen with no identifying marks among any of them.

This scene still occurs in Israel. What is fascinating is that the next morning, one of the shepherds says something to his sheep. One by one, the sheep in his flock file out to follow him. Only his sheep follow his voice.

It's amazing to see: only that shepherd's sheep follow him. The other sheep remain in the pen.
