#5 Former Dedicated Muslim now following Jesus!

Yes, I've decided to follow Jesus. I was a dedicated Muslim for about 22 years. I faithfully prayed five times a day (sometimes even more in Sunnah prayers). Fasted for 30 days out of the year, paid alms religiously, but I could not stop a lot of the bad habits that I'd grown accustomed to (sins). One particular sin was smoking cigarettes. I'd smoked for twenty seven years. One day I was in my cell, and I'd just offered salat (prayers). Begging God to take the smoking away from me, and I heard a still silent voice in my right ear say, "try praying in Jesus' name."

I'd then placed a curtain over my door (I didn't want other Muslims to see me praying like a Christian), and I prayed in faith that God would deliver me from the awful habit of smoking. I then threw away all my cigarettes, lighter, rolling papers and ashtrays, and claimed healing in Christ. I woke up the next day with no compulsion to smoke. That was April 26th, 2005, and I've been a no smoker and a Christian ever since. There are other sinful actions that Christ delivered me from also (like profanity, arguing with authority, etc.), but the one that stood out the most was my cessation from an almost thirty year habit of smoking cigarettes heavy. #9: "I found out in prison, I had full blown aids!"

I have been incarcerated for almost six years now, I thank our Lord that this journey is almost over. I have 9 months remaining on my sentence. Several factors played a role in my return to Jesus. I say return because I was raised in a Catholic family, going to church on a regular basis until my teen years when I veered away from the church.

I began traveling down the path of my own self-destruction. I used as many drugs as I could get my hands on and I was always the life of a party, out drinking all the people who at the time I thought were my friends. I was also very promiscuous, especially during my college years. Finally it caught up with me and I came to prison with a 15 year, split sentence (7 in & 8 probation). In my first month, I also found out I was HIV. Within 4 months of my diagnosis, I had full blown Aids.

I prayed and asked to be forgiven and I began my Prison Mission Bible studies. I accepted Jesus as my Lord and Savior in the summer of 2010. Since then, I have had peace in my life and our good Lord has really looked out for me. Not only is my HIV undetectable but my while blood cells are in the normal range. God inspired a doctor to create the medication Atripla and I am living proof that prayer works! PMA came into my life by a brother in Christ who gave me a one-way ticket! I enjoy doing the studies because they really help me to dig into the word and find meaning. I always look forward to the responses written when I receive my lessons after being graded.
