Here are some highlights from this past year we want to update you on what God has been doing and what we are so grateful for.

# Thankful for Blessing #1. Huge increase of 45% in new students!



Despite the fact we could not go into jails and prisons personally due to COVID-19 restrictions, we see that new students are up by 45% this past year!! Praise the Lord! In 2019, we had 1,256 new

students, and this year in just over 10 months totals, we are at 2,314 new students, on Nov. 11, 2020. This represents many more souls being reached with the gospel!



Due to COVID-19 restrictions, we have had to work out a way so volunteers can work remotely now from home. Many other prison ministries have not been able to continue their ministries since they can no longer go into prisons. Our ministry can not only continue but grow as the mail will still get through. We are blessed that we will be able to continue this important ministry of mentoring and connecting with thousands in growing in their faith in Christ behind bars. Pray for God to raise up more leaders behind bars to do ministry! A **Special shout out to Karen, our office manager who has worked non-stop during this time to keep everything rolling!** Pray for her! We are so thankful that so many can work from home to correct lessons and mail them out to inmates from their homes. We are mailing out lessons to be corrected all across the country with volunteers now in Arkansas, California, Missouri, Michigan, Arizona, and Minnesota, etc. Pastor Dwight spoke at Rush Creek Bible Church Missions Sunday, Oct. 18, 2020, and we had several more new people volunteer to help us! This extended volunteer team has been a blessing and with it has cost us more in postage, but it is well worth it to enable so many more to do this prison ministry! We also are blessed to have more bilingual volunteers helping with Spanish lessons. Please pray for them: Elsa, Jenni, and Irma.



Since there are restrictions now not allowing us to go in person, to visit jails and prisons. It makes it even more important to continue our ministry since the mail is still allowed into the prisons and

jails. We no longer were able to hold in-person worship services at the SuperMax prison at Oak Park Heights, MN. But now with Covid-19, they have given us permission to supply live worship streams recorded by Bethesda Church of Prior Lake, MN that are mailed to them on DVD. Chaplain Paul has agreed to use the DVDs of the live streams to broadcast the worship services on the offender TV channel in the Oak Park Heights MN State Prison. This began June 1, showing every Monday at 9 am each week. We have now sent 32 DVD's to be shown in the prisons. It is our goal to expand this to the other surrounding prisons that will be willing to broadcast our services as well. Please pray for this new outreach!



In the past, we have had the joy of connecting with many inmates through the annual transition fairs in state and federal prisons. These are now going virtual as well. We have created a Transition fair 6-minute video we have brought to women's prison in Shakopee, MN and Men's prisons in Stillwater, MN with several boxes of Bibles, 12 seeds books, and lessons for new students for their recent transition fair. We will be duplicating this to the other surrounding prisons as well.



PMA is developing advanced Biblical leadership and ministry training for church planting curriculum. Pastor Dwight met with Robert Nix and staff at Berean Bible Institute (BBI) on Oct. 19, 2020, to discuss a collaborative effort. BBI has offered to help us with some of the materials so we can adapt courses to fit the prison culture for planting churches there. This is a great help so we do not have to re-invent the wheel in this area. This will be a team effort in developing these new

courses. We also have some other leadership courses we can put on DVD to train those called to help plant the churches behind bars. This is a huge breakthrough for this outreach! We do have one of our PMA graduates who has completed all 35 PMA lessons who is interested in doing these advanced courses and plant a church. Please pray for him, Anthony Roper, in Muskegon Correctional, in Michigan. We have a couple of other graduates who are also considering this opportunity. Pastor Dwight has completed his master's degree from Grace Christian University and has written his master's thesis on "Prison Ministry in a Post Covid 19 World". ## Thankful for Blessing #6. PMA home Office has new water well now!



After our well went dry, we have finally got the new well dug and new pipes, water pump, and system installed! Praise the Lord. We still need about \$4,500 to pay the final bill, but the same God who uses the COVID-19 virus for His glory can provide people to finish the water project. Nothing is too big or little for Him. People are spending more quality time with family and enjoying it. Home improvement projects are on the rise. In prisons and jails, prisoners are spending more time locked up in their cells to reduce the virus's spread. Rather than putting their lives on hold, **some are using their time to allow the Word of God to transform their lives.**

**One last thing**; Did you know that every jail and prison has its own rules about what the inmates can receive in the mail? Individual wardens can make up their own rules regarding procedures to which we must adhere. Things like not allowing colored ink, how many pages are allowed in our

lessons, and the inclusion of other Christian reading materials. One area even photocopies our studies and gives the copies to the prisoners because they are afraid our ink might contain illegal drugs. Trying to keep up with the changes is daunting.

God is working all things together for good (Romans 8:28), so we can praise Him amid the storm.
