Think about your area. The most receptive people to the gospel are close by you but behind bars. They are waiting for someone who knows the Gospel of the Grace of God to come and share it with them. 2 Corinthians 5:17-20

You could have the joy of leading many to Christ! They are looking for hope and know they are sinners and need to change.



Since we have been sharing the vision to plant churches in prisons, God has opened up doors like never before for this ministry in answer to your prayers and support.

Thank YOU for being a part of what God is doing to reach the 2.3 million unreached people group behind bars!

There is no greater spiritual harvest field with a better return of eternal fruit for our investment of time and money of any ministry I have been a part of! We give God the glory for what He has done this past year in tripling the number of new lessons going out in this past year for a total of 3,789 new students.

We have a return rate of 45%, for those who return the intro lessons and tell us they have trusted in Christ. So that means we will have reached over 1,700 new men and women for Christ in jails and prisons in last 12 months! If you divide that by our total budget, we find that for every \$58 donated we were able to reach an inmate for Christ!

We also work to reach the whole family of each inmate with




children's Bible correspondence lessons and books with several ministries we partner with: Grace Harbor- Miners Club and the Mailbox Club.
