#4. My life went from life of complete chaos, depression, anger to life of peace, joy and hope. True freedom in Christ!

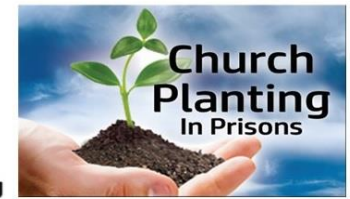
