Please pray for him as he comes to our Bethesda Church, Prior Lake, MN.

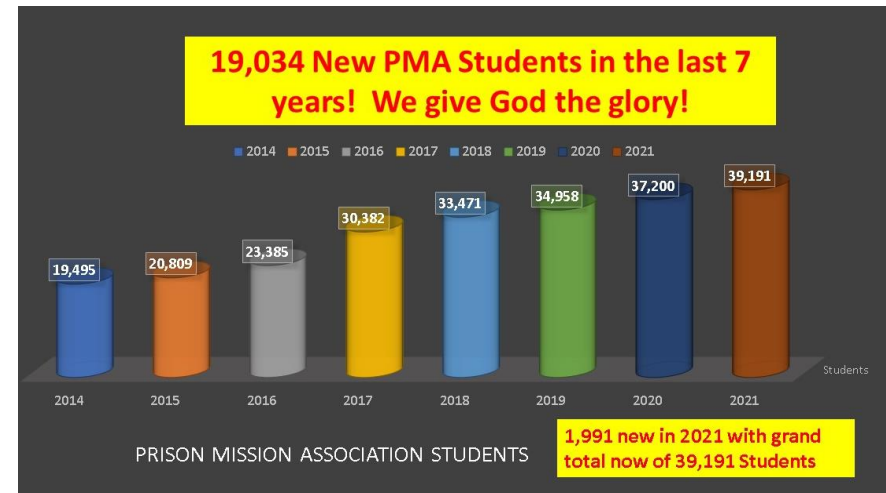

Pray for Obam Hyacinthe, who is distributing our PMA lessons in English but wants them in French. **We need some one to translate them into French.**

Pray for Simone Monfort, our PMA operations manager at our Port Orchard, WA home office as she is recovering from Covid-19 virus. Pray for her and the team as they work to catch up on the work. Pray for her, husband, Mike, who also is recovering from Covid-19 and is now home from being hospitalized. Pray for more volunteers to be able to help in the home office and also to correct lessons from home.

Pray for our **need for a bilingual volunteer** near our Port Orchard, WA office to help with the **Spanish lessons. This continues to be a need that needs to be met.**

Pray as doors are opening to connect with inmates again in MN jails and prisons.
