

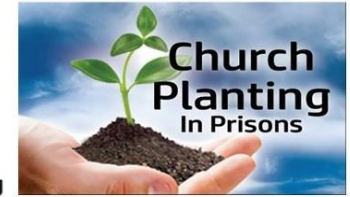

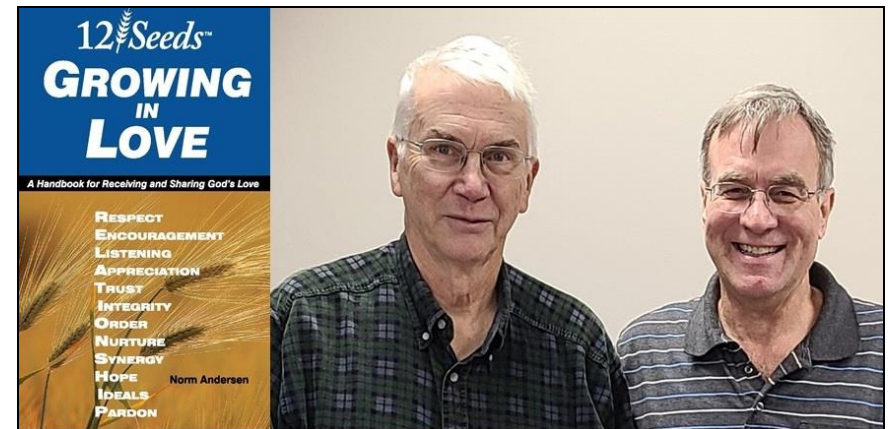

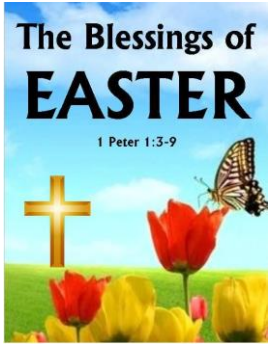
Praise Points
