pornography, alcohol, drugs and money. But I did not find peace in them. Then I end up going to prison and that is where another brother who had the peace I was searching for and also the love that I needed – the love of Jesus who brings eternal life to me. It was like opening up a package which was His gift to me, Praise the Lord!

The Blood Jesus shed on the cross washed away my sins. This is what the brother shared with me that happened in his life. That was God's love he made available to everyone who believes in what he did for us on the cross. But the important part was He was resurrected so we serve a living God through Jesus!

The Correspondence course with Prison Mission helps me to do Bible studies so I can grow in God's grace I received by faith in Jesus. Because at this prison camp here we do not have may Bible studies we can do so I do the ones through the mail. Your studies help me so I can apply what I learn to my life. And that is what they are doing, I study these verse by verse to really know God's truth each and every day. So, I thank you for sending them to me so I can grow in Christ Jesus. God bless you and thank you! "
