The political climate in each facility affects everything and prayer is of the utmost importance. We pray that we are diligent to the very end, so that what we hope for may be fully realized. ... and that we imitate those who through faith and patience inherit what has been promised.

We are **praying for a Spanish Coordinator to** help train a team to correct lessons so we can expand this area of our ministry.

Keep praying for more local churches to start a local Bible Correspondence Fellowship (BCF) so they can reach out to their local jails and prisons. We now have 59 BCFs with 4 new ones including 28 overseas countries! Each BCF prints, distributes, and corrects lessons to mentor inmates so they can reach more inmates for Christ!
