## Praise Points

**Planting Seeds of the Gospel with PMA lessons in Thailand. Here is an update report from Tom Sanchez.**

Tom and Michelle Sanchez, missionaries with Grace Ministries International (GMI) stopped in Thailand and the Philippines to visit their two older children and their spouses on their way back to USA. While in Thailand, Tom was introduced to a housekeeper who is the spouse of a pastor of a church that is predominantly of the minority Li-Su tribe. They had come to Christ in a previous generation as a people but lack quality tools to help pass on Bible knowledge. An-Yi (Thai version of ‘Annie’?) is the

housekeeper/wife of the pastor and she studied at a Bible college in India for a couple of years and may have completed a degree in theology. Tom passed the International English version of the PMA lessons. **An-yi told me that they want to use them and invited me to preach at their local church in Chiang-Mai, Thailand,** Pray for Tom and Michelle Sanchez, our African Liaison for PMA. They are visiting churches in USA now to give reports on their work with GMI. In August-September they will be in Wisconsin, Michigan then head west.



**PMA outreach expands even more in Zambia! New Bible Correspondence Ministry (BCM) in Chingola, Copperbelt, Zambia with Pastor Stephen Kainduin and in Mumbwa with Bishop Mubambe.**

**Pastor Stephen Kaindu,** reported, “We have seen God blessing us in a mighty way. Now in our work, we need more training so that we can be able to reach out to many lost souls. Right now, we have the following programs, we are doing church planting movement in remote areas with local pastors, doing prison ministry, school evangelism, training local pastors, evangelism to the orphans and widows and also refugee camps. Training pastors

and church leaders is very important. It will be a blessing to partner with you to do Prison ministry with PMA lessons.”

**Report from Bishop Mubambe.** “I am a pastor with a passion for inmates. I volunteer to visit correctional facility to conduct some preaching, counseling, and discipleship making. I'm looking for organizations with a passion for inmates who can help or partner with me and my team here in **Mumbwa central province of Zambia.** Inmates faces so many challenges such as blankets, bibles, clothes, study materials. Your PMA lessons will help us to meet this need.
