He has many at the Garland County Detention Center who want to study God’s Word!! **He is setting up a Bible Correspondence Ministry (BCM) there with a team of 6 instructors helping to correct lessons. He will be teaching PMA lessons twice per week. They have 450 detainees at this facility,**

and they are very excited to get this started. It will start the first week of March with one group and then it will expand from there. Here is an update from Kevin: "As Jesus has His hand upon Garland County Detention Center, this ministry continues to grow rapidly and touch many souls. Seeds of faith are being planted daily and changing lives forever. The transformations are truly remarkable that can be only of Jesus Christ and the power of the Holy Spirit. This ministry receives no government funding. 100% of this ministry is funded by local churches, businesses, and private donors. Through Jesus Christ, you make it possible for souls to be reached, touched, transformed, and saved. Thank you for your continued support." Please pray for Chaplain Kevin and his team.
